A people friendly city

As its inhabitants and numerous visitors will tell you, Ljubljana is, indeed, a people-friendly city. Categorised as a medium-sized European city, it offers everything a metropolis does yet preserves its small-town friendliness.

Its geographical position in the centre of Europe has determined Ljubljana as a natural meeting place for merchants and soldiers as well as - and more than once - peacemakers. The victors of the Napoleonic wars selected this peaceful city as the site of the Holy Alliance congress, which in 1821 sealed the European political geography for years to come.

The old meets the new

In Ljubljana the old meets the new; and it seems that history has spent all of the settlement's five millennia preparing it to become the nation's capital. It has managed to retain traces from all periods of its rich history; from the legacy of Roman Emona; through to the Renaissance, Baroque and Art Nouveau periods characterised in the house fronts and ornate doorways of the city centre, the romantic bridges adorning the Ljubljanica river, the lopsided rooftops and a park reaching deep into the city centre. COMPETITION VENUE - HALA TIVOLI



Tivoli Hall (<u>Slovene</u>: Hala Tivoli) is a complex of two multi-purpose indoor sports arenas in the <u>Tivoli City Park</u> in <u>Ljubljana</u>, the capital of Slovenia. The complex was opened in 1965. The larger, <u>ice hockey</u> arena has a seating capacity of 7,000 people and is the home of <u>HK Olimpija</u> ice hockey club. During the <u>EuroBasket</u>

2013, the capacity was adjusted to 5,600.

The smaller <u>basketball</u> hall has a capacity for 4,500 spectators and is the secondary home venue of the basketball team <u>KK Cedevita Olimpija</u>.

Deadline of On-Line registration: 09th November 2023. After that deadline **(09th November 2023)** On-Line Registration will close and a penalty to all further registrations may be applied according to the KFB Rules.

REGISTRATIONS, ACCREDITATION and WEIGH-IN ON-SITE REGISTRATION

Only the head of delegation of every NF should come to the registration and accreditation area with all neccesary documentation for all competitors and other members of delegation.

Steps will be as following:

- 1. The Head of the delegation receives the list of registered participants for reviewal (participants that are registered online)
- 2. In case of changes, the registration and accreditation team updates the list
- 3. The Head of the delegation prepares all passports according to the final list
- 4. The accommodation team compares the registration list to the rooming list to ensure that all registered participants are accommodated in the official accommodation
- 5. The Head of the delegation makes payments according to the final registration list
- 6. The accreditation team issues accreditation cards

WEIGH IN

Weigh-in will be organized for every national federation after the successful registration and accreditation procedure. Weigh-in will happen in the competition venue/ or in hotels 60 minutes after the end of registration and accreditation procedure for every national federation.

Emergencies

Smoking Ban

In most indoor workplaces, indoor public places, sport hall and public transport, smoking is restricted.

Smoking rooms must be noticed exclusively for smoking, may not exceed more than 20 percent of the total surface area, and must meet other technical requirements.

Shops and public services working hours

Banks MON–FRI 9 a.m.–5 p.m. Some banks close their offices at noon for one hour.

ATMs – You can withdraw cash 24 hours a day from most of the ATMs around Slovenia using the MasterCard, Visa, Maestro, Cirrus and Visa Electron Plus cards. There is an exceptionally high number of ATMs in Slovenia. In addition to cash withdrawals, many of them offer other types of

services.

Changing money – exchange offices, hotel receptions, tourist agencies, petrol stations and major shopping centres.


The most important task of the public company Ljubljanski potniški promet d.o.o. is to provide safe, reliable and smooth-running public transport in the area of the entire City Municipality of Ljubljana and sixteen suburban municipalities.The density of the network facilitates easy connectivity between different urban quarters, making daily commutes more convenient for passengers.

Through the acquisition of new, modern buses, regular driver training, optimization of schedules, and many other projects and measures for sustainable mobility, we continually enhance the quality of public transportation services. As a result, an increasing number of people are consciously choosing public transport in Ljubljana and its vicinity.All urban buses are airconditioned, low-floor, and mostly equipped with ramps for individuals with disabilities. They are standardly fitted with audible and visual announcements of stops, and 125 buses are also equipped with video screens indicating transfer points to other lines. The majority of urban buses are equipped with interior cameras. This proactive approach enhances passenger safety by providing a sense of security within monitored areas.

Ljubljanski potniški promet actively responds to technological changes, making the use of public transport more convenient for all generations. Through the Urbana app, you can plan your routes and access information about all forms of urban mobility. In the city center, electric vehicles Kavalir and the Urban train are available. The Kavalir service is free and intended for those with limited mobility, providing easier access to important destinations within the pedestrian zone.

Exploring the city with the Urban train is an attraction you shouldn't miss in Ljubljana. The circular route features 10 stations, including the city's major landmarks. Urban starts its circular route in the vicinity of the Town Hall, it goes to the Ljubljana Castle, then takes you alongside the banks of the Ljubljanica River over the Trnovski pristan Embankment, through the contemporary centre of Ljubljana, past the Opera, the Modern Gallery and the Prešeren Square with the Triple Bridge, returning to the starting point. The main city attractions are introduced by an audio guide available in fourteen languages (Slovenian, English, German, Italian, Croatian, French, Spanish, Russian, Portuguese, Dutch, Chinese, Greek, Arabic, and Hungarian).

Ljubljanski potniški promet is recognized as a model of good practice in creating sustainable and interconnected urban mobility. Through its dedication to the environment, innovation, and passenger comfort, it significantly contributes to a higher quality of life in Ljubljana.
